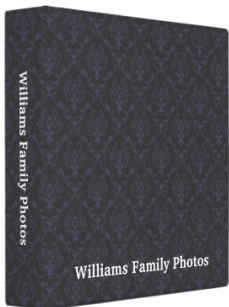
## They Ought To Be In Pictures!
